Dear Parents/Carers,

In line with membership of other swimming clubs we will be charging a set fee for all swimmers, depending on whether they are in the junior or senior squad. Therefore, membership fees from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018 are as follows:

- Junior Squad = £21.50 per month
- Senior Squad = £28.00 per month

NB: All siblings will be charged at £21.00 per month.

### Training Times

#### Junior Squad (3hrs pool time per week)

Monday	6.00pm to 7.00pm
Thursday	7.30pm to 8.30pm
Sunday	3.30pm to 4.30pm

#### Senior Squad (5hrs pool time per week)

Monday	7.00pm to 8.00pm
Wednesday	8.00pm to 9.00pm
Thursday	7.30pm to 8.30pm
Sunday	3.30pm to 5.30pm

NB: All squad fees include synchro, if swimmers would like to attend.

To train or compete with Ryde Swimming Club, all swimmers **must** have ASA membership, which provides insurance for the swimmer. This is a one-off payment each year and the cost for 2018 is as follows:

- Category 1 – £15 (non-competitive)
- Category 2 – £32 (competitive)

NB: ASA membership should be paid into the club account.

## **Pay as You Go Option**

Swimmers who choose not to pay by monthly standing order can pay £4.00 per session, so long as they are a member of Ryde Swimming Club and have paid their ASA membership fee. However, unlike those who pay by standing order this does not guarantee you a place at the relevant training session, as we cannot exceed the maximum number of swimmers allowed per session. For this reason, pay as you go swimmers **must** check with the head or designated coach that there is space to swim before entering the pool.

NB: Swimmers who are not members of Ryde Swimming Club will be charged £5.00 per session but they **must** still have ASA membership and check that there is space available in the pool.
